



## SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Dear Art Teacher and Art Student:

The School of Art at Montana State University-Bozeman would like to announce our 2013 scholarship competition, February 25, 2014. This year, we will be awarding 2 -\$3,000 nonrenewable scholarships to high school seniors based on a portfolio review.

**SUBMISSION OF WORK** - The scholarship awards will be based primarily on a portfolio review of your original artwork, a short essay and your grade point average (GPA). Portfolios should consist of 10 images and all artwork must be represented on a CD in jpg format, pick the representation of your artwork to use. Images must be clearly labeled with the corresponding number from the entry form, your last name, and the title of the image. Good quality images are important. No photographs, original work, PowerPoint presentations or labels on the CD please. The essay requirement is a one page typed, 12-point font, single-spaced essay based on your personal art experiences and what you hope to do with a career in art. Work with your high school art teacher, they will be able to help you put together your portfolio and essay.

You may ship, email or drop off your portfolio to: **Scholarship Competition, School of Art 213 Haynes Hall, Montana State University, Bozeman, MT 59717-3680, [art@montana.edu](mailto:art@montana.edu).** Your portfolio must arrive no later than February 25, 2014 and contain a completed entry form. Please make as many copies of the enclosed entry form as needed.

**JURYING** - The scholarship competition will be juried by a committee of School of Art faculty. The jury will be looking for a high level of artistic skill and creativity which indicates a readiness for college level art courses, some understanding of different media and evidence of serious interest in the visual arts as seen through approach and presentation.

- Your CD must include ten images, one image per piece of artwork. Choose an image that best represents each piece.
- All images must be in jpg format, clearly labeled with your last name and title of work.  
- EXAMPLE: 01yourlastname.titleofpiece.jpg
- No PowerPoint presentations or labels on CDs
- CDs will not be returned
- Essay requirement: 1 page essay based on your personal art experiences and what you hope to gain in your chosen art profession, typed, 12 point font, single spaced on a separate page.
- All submissions must be recieved by the deadline - Late work will not be considered
