The School of Art at Montana State University-Bozeman would like to announce our 2017-2018 scholarship competition, February 20, 2017. This year, we will be awarding 2 -\$3,000 scholarships to high school seniors based on our portfolio requirements.


**SUBMISSION OF WORK** - The scholarship awards will be based primarily on a portfolio review of a CD of work, grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher, and a short essay. Portfolios should consist of 10 works and all work must be represented in jpg format on a usb drive, no photographs or original work will be accepted, pick the best view of each image to use. Images must be clearly labeled with your name, corresponding number from the entry form and the title of the image. No PowerPoint presentations or labels on the CD please. The essay requirement is a one page typed, 12-point font, single-spaced essay based on your personal art experiences and what you hope to do with a career in art.

Please ship your portfolio or drop off in person to: **Scholarship Competition, School of Art 213 Haynes Hall, Montana State University, Bozeman, MT 59717-3680 and arrange for it to arrive no later than 4:30 p.m., February 20, 2017. Each portfolio *must* contain a completed entry form. Please make as many copies of the enclosed entry form as needed.**

**JURYING** - The scholarship competition will be juried by a committee of School of Art faculty. The jury will be looking for a high level of artistic skill and creativity which indicates a readiness for college level art courses, some understanding of different media and evidence of serious interest in the visual arts as seen through approach and presentation. Good quality images are important. Work with your high school art teacher, they will be able to help you put together your portfolio.

- USB drive must include 10 images, 1 image per piece of artwork. Choose an image that best represents each piece.
- All images must be in jpg format, clearly labeled with your last name and title of work.  
- **EXAMPLE: 01yourlastname.titleofpiece.jpg**
- **No PowerPoint presentations, slide shows or videos.**
- **USB drives will not be returned**
- Essay requirement: 1 page essay based on your personal art experiences and what you hope to gain in your chosen art profession, typed, 12 point font, single spaced saved as a separate file.
- **All submissions must be recieved by the deadline - Late work will not be considered**
